Layout and HTML5 elements

 Currently the app is a single page. To add new sites we need some form of navigation for the user. Add a header, a sidebar and a footer. Wrap the main content in an element too! You want to use the new HTML5 elements introduced (nav, header, section, footer). Add placeholders into the header and navigation.

After this step the site will look really silly. Do not fret: We will remedy that in the next step

- Add the necessary CSS to mimic the layout to the right. Make it work on your screen, do not worry about resizing. Add this CSS to styles.css
